

Hosting Club Demonstration Events

CSC permits member clubs to host demonstration events in accordance to the policies and procedures of the association. Demonstration events are a positive way to prepare new athletes for the structure and stresses of sanctioned competition.

CSC encourages clubs to run such events; however the event must adhere to specific policies. The specific policies can be found in the CSC Policy Manual under section the Program Policies (I. Q.)

The following is a summary of the CSC Policy:

APPROVED DEMONSTRATION EVENTS

CSC Member clubs are permitted to host demonstration events in which their club highlights the programs and services offered by the club.

Demonstration events that involve any form of sparring must conform to the following rules and regulations:

- i. All Sparring must be light and controlled
- ii. All participants must have regulation equipment and larger size gloves.
- iii. All participants in sparring must be registered with CSC and be from CSC Clubs
- iv. No decisions can be communicated in any manner during or after the event
- v. The event must be marketed as a demonstration or exhibition event only
- vi. Participants not from CSC Clubs are not permitted to participate
- vii. All promotional material (print & social media) must have the following statement:

The following event is not a competition and only has demonstration sparring. For information on sanctioned competitions please see the Combative Sports Canada Calendar page at – www.KickboxingCanada.org

CSC Clubs hosting demonstration events must inform the CSC office a minimum of 60 days prior to the event. CSC reserves the right to send an appointed official of CSC to observe the event to ensure that all CSC policies are met.



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
